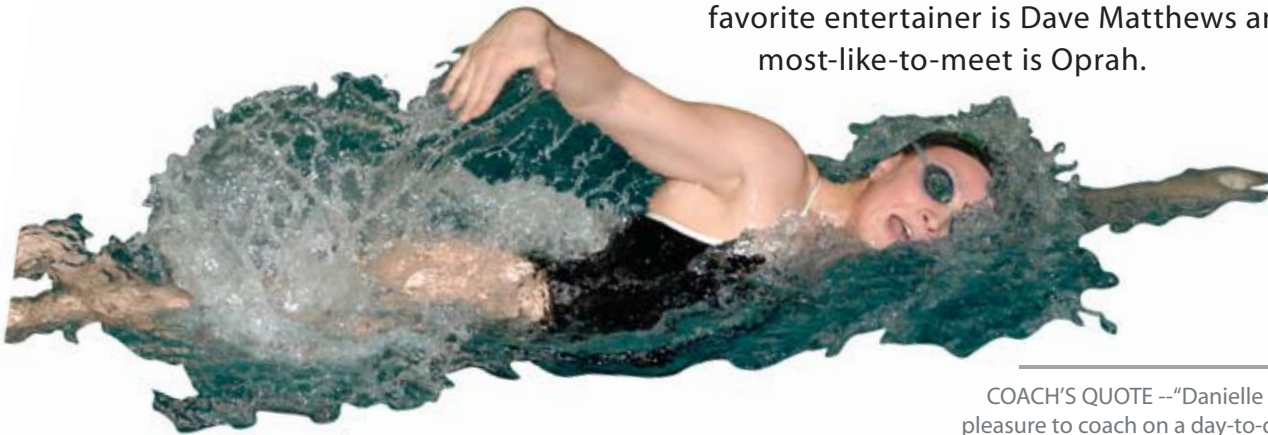


Danielle Jansen
