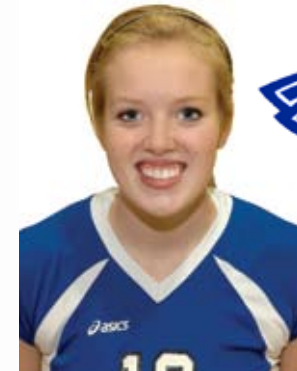


## Lauren O'Conner

Prior to breaking a finger earlier this season, Lauren O'Conner was proving her reputation as one of Kentucky's top volleyball players, ranked 31st best in the USA by PrepVolleyball.com and named an alternate on the USA Junior Olympic volleyball Team. Last season, Lauren recorded 430 kills, 160 digs, 49 blocks and 54 aces in leading the district champions. She was the first in school history to record 1,000+ career kills.
