

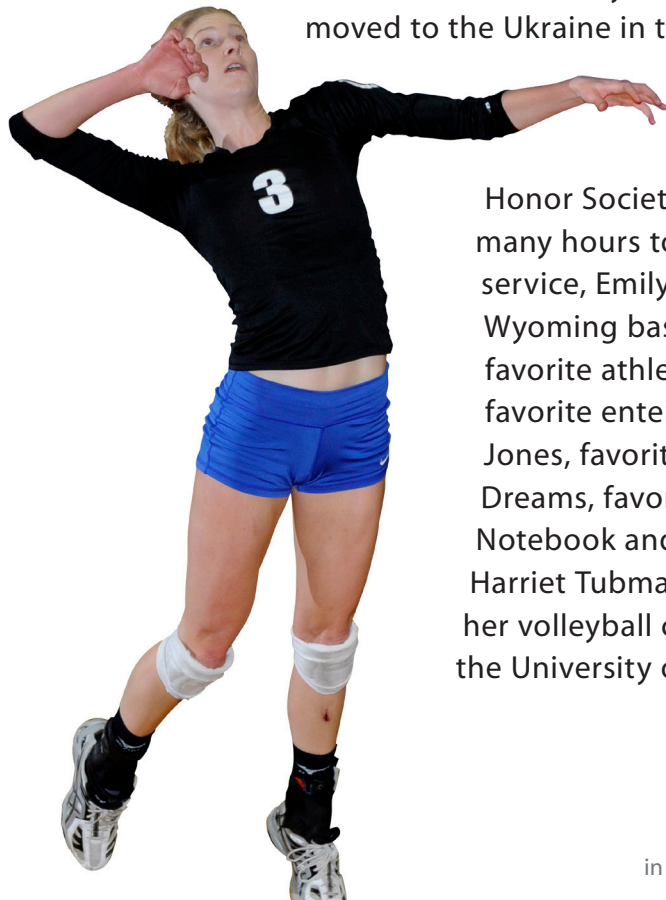
Emily Fraik
