

championships in the 200 (21.64). He was named 1st team FAVC East, 1st team all-city (Enquirer) and 1st team all-Ohio. Also a super football player, running back Kenneth helped the Eagles (8-3) get to the Ohio Div. I playoffs for the first time in school

history. The running back ran for 1,575 yards (24 TDs) and was named FAVC Cardinal Co-Player of the Year,

1st team all-city (Enquirer), 1st team all-SWO district and special mention all-Ohio. An honor student active in community service, Kenneth will play football next year at Robert Morris University. His favorite athlete is Barry Sanders, favorite entertainer is Kevin Hart and most-like-to-meet is President Obama.
