One of the area's elite pro-style QBs and team captain, Wyoming senior Andrew Marty fought back from a junior year season-ending injury to lead the Cowboys this year to an undefeated 10-0 regular season record and the CHL league title.

During the regular season, Andrew led the CHL in passing yards (2,487) and passing TDs (34) plus had 7 TDs rushing. His 6 TD passes vs. Deer Park tied a school record for TD passes in a game. Andrew continued his QB mastery in the first round of the Div.IV regional playoffs last Friday night. In a 59-0 win vs. Chillicothe Unioto, Andrew passed for 254 yards and five touchdowns to keep the Cowboys undefeated season rolling at 11-0.

Andrew also plays baseball for the Cowboys and last season on the mound he struck out 26 batters in 25.2 innings and had a 1.44 ERA.

A good student active in community service, Andrew will play football collegiately at Northwestern University.
